Christopher, known to his friends as “Drew” was a 32-year-old man who passed away in the shooting at the Pulse nightclub in Orlando Florida. Drew was known as an easy-going person who loved meeting new people. He was born in Detroit, Michigan and had no kids. Drew worked to preserve the dignity and respect of the gay community by creating gay-straight alliance clubs during his formative educational development in both middle and high school. After earning his graduate degree in clinical psychology from the University of Central Florida, Drew worked as a mental health counselor in various hospitals in the Orlando area diagnosing and counseling people living with mental illnesses who were homeless.

AMENDMENT
